

TRANS MAN/BOY, NON-BINARY AND GENDER FLUID PLAYER PARTICIPATION RFU NOTIFICATION FORM



Please refer to the **RFU's Gender Participation Policy** for more detailed information on the eligibility criteria for participation in rugby.

The policy sets out that where a player's sex recorded at birth is female and the player identifies as transgender, non-binary or gender fluid, the player may play in the male category (U12s and above) if:

- the player / their parent or guardian (or such other appropriate adult) provides their written consent, in the form prescribed by the RFU, to the relevant club or school*; and
- an appropriate risk assessment is carried out by the club, school, college or university which the player is representing*; and
- the RFU is notified prior to the player participating in the contact rugby activity.
- The player (adult players only) has obtained a therapeutic use exemption if required by **RFU Regulation 20**.

This form should be used to notify the RFU that an individual who identifies as transgender, non-binary or gender fluid, wants to play in the male category.

This form should be sent to the RFU via email to genderparticipation@rfu.com following the club/school obtaining appropriate consent and completing a risk assessment. The consent form and risk assessment template are available on the **Gender Participation page** on the England Rugby website.

* Should a player not wish to disclose their gender identity to their club or school, the player may contact the RFU on a confidential basis via genderparticipation@rfu.com to discuss an alternative process.
