YC issued as per the HCP.				



## Summary of any mitigating and aggravating features:

No mitigation can be applied to reduce the entry point of one week.

The Player has two previous red cards on his record. The first from September 2019 (RFU) which resulted in a 3 week ban for Dangerous Tackling. The second red was in November 2022 (WR) which was also for a dangerous tackle and resulted in a 4 week suspension (following which he completed the WR CIP). As a result of the Players record, one week was added on to the entry point as an aggravating feature.

The final sanction to be applied is 2 weeks.
