#### Summary of Essential Elements of Citing/Referee/s Report/Footage

The Referee's report describes the incident as follows:

It was at a scrum reset. A penalty was awarded to Hornets on the opposite side. The players came up from the scrum and moved away. This is when Clifton 3 was trying to get to Hornets 1 (unsure what has provoked this). A few players were keeping him back when Hornets 1 came towards him. Clifton 3 grabbed his left arm and the Hornets 1 the head butted the Clifton 3. We players were separated and moved away from each other. I have then spoken to the Hornets captain and Hornets 1 to talk through the incident. I then issued the red card for Hornets 1.

The video footage was consistent with the Referee's description of the incident.







The e-mail from the Player stated as follows:

My name is Rueben Brown and on Saturday 18th February 2023 I was playing rugby for Hornets at home. I was playing loosehead and after about 28 minutes we had scrum near to the touchline close to the stand. As a result of an infringement by them we had a penalty awarded to us. Their tighthead walked past me retreating to 10 metres and as he did I gave him a little pat on the back. This was just a little bit of gamesmanship on my part and couldn't possibly have been construed as anything else. I was shocked therefore when he became enraged and shoved me hard, twice. If I'm honest I was not expecting it.

He was being held by 2 of our players and I was just smiling thinking what a ridiculous over reaction from him. As I approached him in a very non threatening manner, with my arms down by my sides he reached out with his right hand, grabbed the front of my shirt and pulled me sharply towards him. He was still clearly very angry. I could see the tension in his face and his neck muscles. My first and immediate reaction was that he was going to headbutt me. In order to protect my face I have dipped my head so that if he did make contact with my head it would not contact the soft flesh of my face but my forehead/head.

The referee has then blown his whistle several times and as a result of what he has seen I was sent off. I apologised to the referee after the game but was unable to find the player to apologise to as I had to leave fairly quickly after the game. I can see why the referee thought that I was the aggressor but the lack of any injury to the other player I hope indicates that this was a purely defensive manoeuvre with my head and not an attacking one designed to cause pain and/or injury.

At the hearing, the Player explained the incident to the Panel as described above. He described the contact between heads as slight.
