# ENCOURAGING GIRLS TO GIVE RUGBY A GO

Here are some considerations you should plan for in preparation for delivering girls' rugby at your school or college:

- What age will you offer rugby to and why?
- Do you have enough capacity to provide a variety of options?
- Can you run girls only sessions or mixed (non-contact only)?
- When will rugby be offered in curriculum time, lunchtime clubs or afterschool clubs?

- What clashes need to be avoided?
- What is the cost to parents?
- How will you engage and promote the benefits of rugby to parents and pupils?
- Are there local clubs that you can work with?





# ENCOURAGING GIRLS TO GIVE RUGBY A GO

For girls to feel welcome and excited to play rugby, it is vital that they have access to the right provisions. This includes having secure and separate changing facilities, equal use of pitches and outdoor areas to the boys, and kit that is specifically for girls to make them feel valued. Offering girls-only touch sessions would be a great way to encourage girls to play, where they can feel safe and confident in learning a new skill. If this is successful and the girls have found their confidence, mixing them with the boys could then be an option to build bigger game opportunities and include everyone.

You will find that some girls really enjoy rugby and they may want to continue to play rugby at a club. It would be good to gather a list of clubs and make initial contact with them to provide a direct pathway. You may also find that coaches from those clubs offer to come into your school/college to deliver some sessions, building great relationships. Within the education pathway, you could have older students who wish to support rugby activity within younger age groups, alongside teachers. Facilitating this is a great way to build a rugby-playing community within education.


